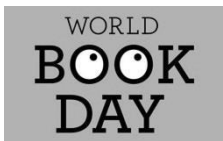
Thought of the Week

There will be the following changes to the school menu:

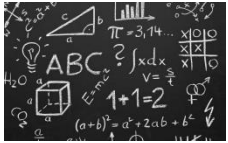
