
Mansfield Museum Trips

We are hoping to gather small amounts of frog spawn for some of the classes to observe the growth of tadpoles to frogs before we release them back to the place where the spawn was gathered. Scarlet Fever

We have had a case of Scarlet Fever in the school - at this time, it is only the second case with quite a few weeks between them. Please make sure you are aware of the symptoms by using the NHS website and visit your doctor if you think your child has contracted it. It is usually treated with antibiotics.

Head Lice



We have an increasing number of children coming to school with head lice. The only treatment that is 100% effective is regular combing of the hair with a Nitty Gritty comb and lots of conditioner. Once under control, a weekly comb will prevent any other infestations. Please can you make time to check your child, treat if necessary and have a weekly check. In addition, all long hair should be tied up to help prevent infestations. Thank you for your support.
